## MPA Program(s) Description or Highlights:

- MPA network (2019): 23.5% of EEZ (97% in Overseas), 546 MPAs
- New Protected Areas strategy (in land and at sea) under development -> 30% by 2030 with 10% strong protection - Objectives: A resilient PA network; An efficient and adapted PAs management; Sustainable activities inside PAs; Better integrate PAs network within territories; Include the French PAs network the global governance for the benefice of Nature

## Key Program Challenges/Priorities:

- Large variety of MPAs and managers
- Starting renewing the management plans of Marine Nature Parks (10-year duration)
