#### Mission statement

The IUCN SSC Tapir Specialist Group (TSG) is a global group of biologists, zoo professionals, researchers and advocates dedicated to conserving tapirs and their habitat through strategic action planning in countries where tapirs live, information sharing, and through educational outreach that shows the importance of the tapir to local ecosystems and to the world at large.

#### Projected impact 2021-2025

By the end of 2025, we want to have strong group representation in all tapir range countries in Latin America and Southeast Asia and stable, long-term research and conservation programmes in several of these countries.

### Targets 2021–2025 ASSESS

**T-001** Establish joint tapir research and conservation programmes including multiple tapir species and range countries.

**T-002** Establish a network of tapir research and conservation programmes representing all tapir range countries.

#### **PLAN**

T-003 Publish a visual, popular version of at least two TSG action plans – Baird's Tapir (*Tapirus bairdii*) and Mountain Tapir (*Tapirus pinchaque*) – condensed, accessible and mobile for use.

#### **NETWORK**

T-004 Expand the TSG fellowship.

**T-005** Integrate our education curriculum 'Tapir Tracks' with education programmes.

**T-006** Involve TSG members in at least three TSG strategic plan actions.

**T-007** Obtain a minimum of 10 new alliances between ex situ and in situ conservation efforts.

**T-008** Resurrect the tapir conservation newsletter
