#### HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE CHALLENGE

To make the most of this challenge, please prepare and bring the following data to document your contributions.

#### Mandatory Data

- Geographical boundary of your project (Spatial polygon)
  - You can upload your own polygon or create your project boundary on screen.
  - Or you can select any Protected Areas or Key Biodiversity Areas polygons if your project contributes to that.
- Start and end dates of the project

### Optional Data

- → Partner names (you can tag multiple partners)
- **⇔** Biodiversity activities:
  - Threat abatement actions (Refer to IUCN Threat Classification Scheme)
  - Conservation actions (Refer to IUCN Conservation Actions Classification Scheme)
- Restoration activities: Forest and landscape restoration actions.
- Social benefits: Number of staff & beneficiaries differentiated by gender.
- → Financial details: Total annual budget required and annual budget already secured.
- **→Attachments:** Photographs, Reports
