

What is SSC One Stop Shop?

- A site developed by the SSC Chair's Office in partnership with the Global Center for Species Survival.
- One centralized location for all the resources offered to the SSC network. Better organization of the resources through the creation of sections, categories, and subcategories.

IUCN Website

- The website serves as the official public platform for IUCN, therefore all content is carefully moderated.
- The *Expert Commissions* webpages are specially designed to provide information about IUCN Commissions, Commission group directories, major events, projects, awards, publications, articles, announcements and reports.

What is SSC DATA?

- SSC DATA is the Species Survival Commission's systematic process of monitoring the activities carried out by the Network to effectively evaluate results.
- SSC DATA is key to knowing how the SSC Groups are doing, what targets they are pursuing, their core and partnership needs, and what they achieve each year.

What is CMS?

- The IUCN's sole official platform for managing membership across all seven Commissions.
- Those interested in applying for Commission membership should formally register and submit an application through the CMS.
- Allows users to edit and update their profile information easily.

What is IUCN Engage?

- Virtual Community to communicate, collaborate, host and join events.
- Promotes active participation and collaboration among Commission members and across various thematic groups within the Commissions.
- Dedicated space for all IUCN constituents, including Members, Commissions, and the Secretariat.

What is Union Portal?

- Web-based, password-protected system to search for and obtain information on Councillors, Members Organisations, National and Regional Committees, Commission Members and the Secretariat.
- It can be utilized as a private or public repository by the IUCN constituent units.
