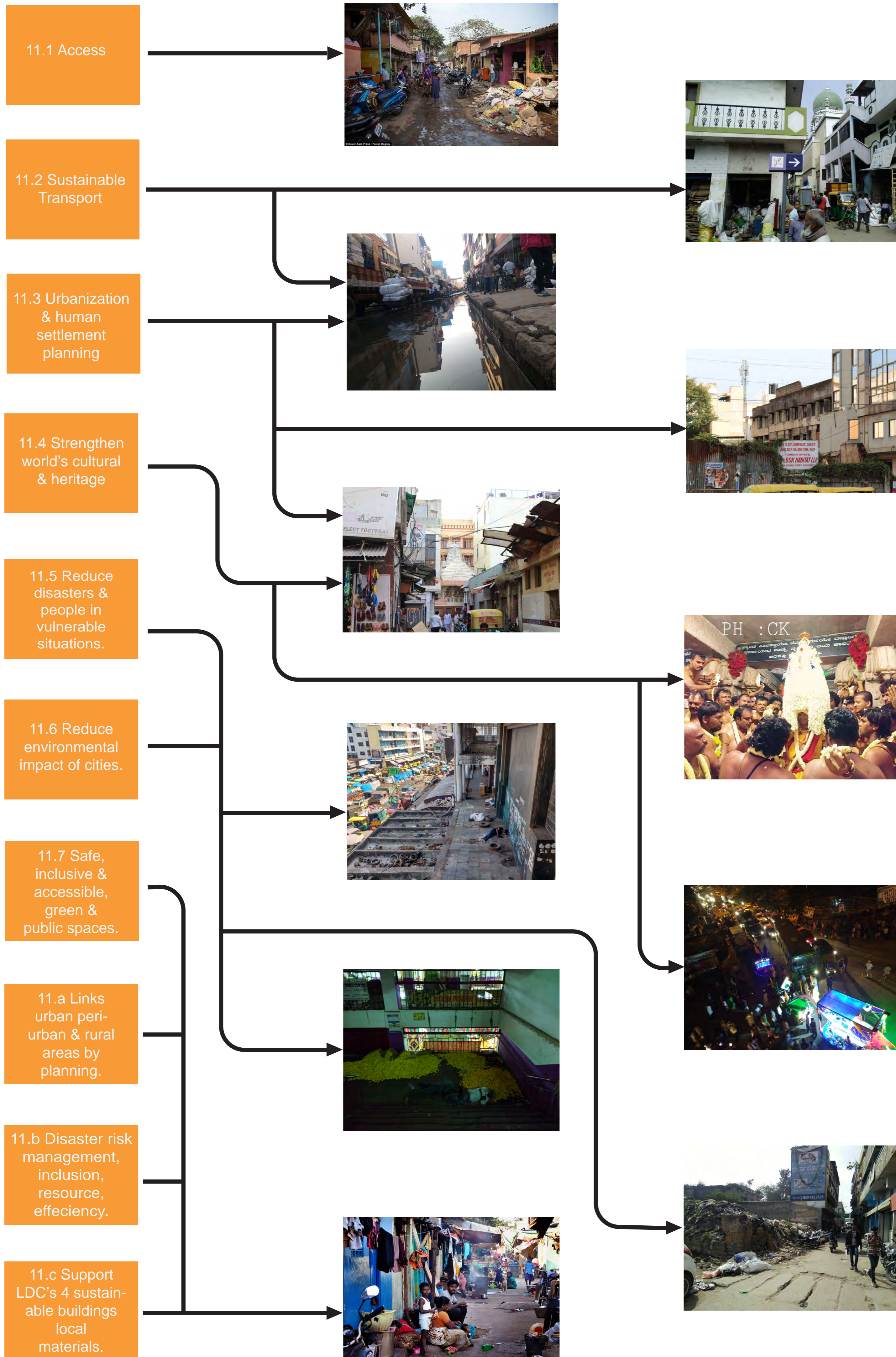


# Sustainability and Cities

Bangalore petta over the years has developed and expanded organically. If we see the history of petta, it was developed according to the lifestyles of the communities living there. Today also the sewage and drainage system of the area is well planned but not maintained, thus creating unhygienic living conditions.

Petta has a history of plague outbreak due to unhygienic living conditions. Today also the roads and drains are flooded by sewage water in some parts. Many old structures in petta are beyond their life span standing in very bad conditions.

Due to rapid urbanization and nature of petta, there is a lot of floating population in the area. The area acts differently at different interval of times.
