IUCN Caribbean Initiative: Programme for 2009 – 2012

After a broad consultation, analysis and discussion process that has involved all members and key partners of IUCN, and with the Governments of France and Italy, the IUCN Caribbean Initiative: Programme 2009 – 2012 has been developed. This Initiative was launched at the past World Conservation Congress that took place in Barcelona, last October 2008, and approved by members. The document contains a summary of the Situation Analysis for the Wider Caribbean (IUCN, 2007), a statement of general principles that should guide the design and implementation of the Initiative, including an interpretation of the IUCN Value Proposition as applied to this region and a set of results showing the proposed contribution of the Caribbean Initiative to IUCN's global Programme for 2009–2012.

Each intercessional result is supported by a justification and shows the means by which the result will be achieved, including proposed partnerships for implementation.
